

Thank you for signing up to the Children's Architectural Model Competition 2023!

Below you will find information on where to bring and collect your models and how to display them for judging and the exhibition over the weekend. ### Model Drop Off

Please bring your completed model to the Otho Peter Suite at Launceston Town Hall (pL15 7AR) on **Friday 16th June anytime between 9am and 1pm**. There will be tables on either side of the room for each age class (4-7 and 8-11), please place your model in any space on the table for the appropriate age category. Access to the building will be from the Dockey side via either:

- the red side door to the right of the outside noticeboard. Turn left on entry, the OP suite is the first door on the left.
- if the side door is not open, please use the main entrance through the glass door and follow the signs for the Otho Peter Suite.

### Model Collection

You can collect your model from the same location on **Sunday 18th June anytime between 12pm and 3pm.**

### Parking/Travel

If you are unable to attend on foot, the closest place to park is the Westgate St multi storey (PL15 8BA) situated next door to the town hall. The closest bus stop is located on Westgate St.

### Labelling

Please label models with a name and age however you wish. This can be on your model, on a small slip of paper next to your model or perhaps a folded piece of card so it stands up; be as creative as you like! It is up to you whether you would like to include a written narrative on or next to your model but it is not compulsory.

### Judging and Prizegiving

Judging will take place once all models are in place on the afternoon of the 16th June.

Unfortunately the judging process will not be available to spectators but you will be able to find out the winners during public viewing over Saturday and Sunday. Prizes will be placed next to
